1. <u>Purpose</u>. To publish regulations, policies and procedures concerning the installation and operation of amateur radio and citizens band stations with this Command, including the Navy-Marine Corps Military Affiliate Radio Systems (MARS).

2. Cancellation. NAS PAXRIV Instruction 2070.2H.

3. Policy

- a. Per the references, this Command supports and encourages amateur radio activities, including an amateur radio station and a Navy-Marine Corps Military Affiliate Radio System (MARS) station. A military recreation station custodian shall be designated in writing per reference (b). Enclosure (1) is a sample letter. All amateur radio and citizens band operations are subject to Federal Communications Commission (FCC) regulations. Licensing and operating procedures shall be in accordance with the references. All operators shall be aware of Hazards of the Electromagnetic Radiation to Ordnance (HERO) concerns and shall ensure compliance with reference (c). The military recreation station custodian shall be responsible and accountable to the Air Operations Officer via the Ground Electronics Maintenance (GEM) Division for all government electronic equipment.
- b. No amateur radio or citizens band installation or operations will be permitted aboard this station except as duly authorized by the FCC and the Commanding Officer. The station licensee is directly responsible to the FCC for the proper operation of the Station.

- c. Fixed Operations: Personnel planning to operate fixed amateur radio or citizens band stations within the confines of the Command must obtain approval using enclosure (2) from the GEM Officer (GEMO) before establishing a station. Prior coordination with the Naval Air Station/Air Operations Department HERO Control Officer and the Naval Air Station Safety Officer will be required as well. The GEMO shall approve or disapprove all applications for establishing fixed stations by direction of the Commanding Officer, Naval Air Station.
- d. Mobile Operations: Mobile Stations operating within the confines of the Command are not permitted to exceed output power limitations imposed by FCC regulations for the respective service. Mobile operators must comply with transmitting restrictions as outlined in reference (c) and paragraph 4d below.
- 4. Action. Amateur radio and citizens band operators shall:
- a. Familiarize themselves with the contents of the references, which are available in the GEMO's Office, Building 426, and at the Amateur Radio Station, Building 105.
- b. Obtain written permission from the GEMO before establishing a fixed amateur radio or citizens band station within the confines of the Command.
- c. Adhere to all FCC regulations and policies governing amateur radio and citizens band operations.
- d. Not operate a mobile station transmitter in proximity to the receiver sites at Cedar Point, the Air Operations Building, Strike Aircraft Test Directorate, taxiways, or aircraft.
 - e. Notify the GEMO when fixed station operation will be discontinued.
- 5. Review authority. The GEMO shall review this instruction annually, making changes as necessary.
