February Meeting:

The February meeting of the Kentucky Mountains Amateur Radio Club was held on February 19th., at the Mother of Good Counsel Catholic Church, in Hazard. Ten members were present and Wayne Hensley led the winter project day with a project for warm weather use, the construction of an active attenuator for Fox Hunting.

Wayne had the parts and enclosures for the project, and Bob, WB4IEA, helped supply coax connectors and tools for building the attenuators. Five or six were successfully completed.

Fox Hunting is an activity in which hams or teams hunt one hidden transmitter, whose location is unknown. Wayne has already built the automatic annunciator, which, when used with a 2 meter or UHF radio, will key the transmitter every few minutes as set on the annunciator, and provide tones to help in the location of the signal.

Directional antennas are used to determine the location of the hidden transmitter, or Fox. The attenuator which we built is used between the antenna and the receiver to lower the received signal strength so that the directional antenna may be turned to peak the signal. If the signal is too strong, there will be no null or peak. The signal has to be lowered or attenuated as you get closer to the Fox, so that a peak or null can be observed.

Practical applications for Fox Hunting equipment include locating interfering signals and illegal transmitters. Perhaps a hidden Fox Hunt is next, after the proper antennas are made.

To help plan future project days, which are some of the best club meetings, President Tim Osborne appointed a committee consisting of Wayne, AF4YJ, Bob, WB4IEA, and Morris, WB4NZS, to come up with ideas for at least two project days per year.
