To sign up go to www.arrl.org and go through the registration and log-in on the first page. You will need your membership card or a recent copy of QST to get your membership number from the mailing label. When registering, use your call sign as your "User Name" and select a convenient password. During the registration process, you will be given the opportunity to request e-mail bulletins such as the News Letter and DX bulletins. These will be automatically sent to you via e-mail from the ARRL reflector. This is a service you have already paid for. Use it.

Minutes of the WCARA Business Meeting for March

Thursday March 24, 2005 at Boondoggles Restaurant

President Dave Price, KD4AAG, Started the meeting at 7:40PM. To begin, he welcomed all members and visitors. Then, Dave and Rhonda price gave out door prizes and notepads to all present. Dave then recognized those members present who usually could not make the Saturday Breakfast meeting.

16 members and 6 guests were present. Dave then asked Kirk Ellis to read the minutes from the March meeting. After reading a summary, Wilbert Musselman WD4THE was called on for the treasurer's report. He reported \$900.00 exactly in the treasury. A telephone bill of \$23 for the autopatch was paid, and the club's \$4000 insurance policy for the year was paid. This coverage cost \$76.

Dave then called on Craven Malpass, W4NZS, to report on the 146.85 repeater. Craven reported that the repeater announcements had been changed to indicate the new CTCSS (PL) of 88.5. Presently, the repeater is running carrier squelch, allowing all those who need to change hardware or reprogram radios time to do so.

Dave Price next recognized former club officers present and members of 20 years or more.

Dave called on Kirk Ellis, Trustee of GARC's repeaters, to report on the status. 145.33 is also running carrier squelch, allowing all those who need to change hardware or reprogram radios time to do so. The announcements have also been changed. The repeater is scheduled to revert to CTCSS operation April 16 2005. The 443 repeater will likewise be changed in the near future.

Kirk then passed around the Ramsey CTCSS board kit. These are going to be ordered for club members or any ham's with radios without tone. The cost will be \$12 each, and the boards will be ordered April 11 2005.

Dave then called on Ray Lane for the field day report. Reiterating the location, Ray told about what was planned. Also, discussion ensued on the possibility of obtaining a boom truck. And, a motion was made and a unanimous vote held to obtain a portable toilet for field day. The expense will be shared 50/50 with GARC.

There was no other new business. Dave Price then introduced Dave Roy, who presented a concise and interesting program on Skywarn at 8PM.

The meeting adjourned at about 8:20 PM.
