

"Space X-ISS" - March, 2019



From Rod W8GRI:

I have been watching Space X's launch of the Falcon rocket with the Crew Dragon and it's docking with the International Space Station....
This morning Crew Dragon departed the ISS and is scheduled to splash down in the Atlantic about 9ish. Watching this carefully and going to https://spotthestation.nasa.gov/tracking_map.cfm, I went out side my home in Michigan's Upper Peninsula and waited.... at just about 5:25 AM EST I spotted the ISS and just head of it was a small bright spot that must be Crew Dragon! A clear morning here and quite cold, about +3 degrees F. The ISS was about the brightness of Venus and Crew Dragon was much dimmer! What a site!

I have seen the ISS many times as when it's orbit is in the right path it passes over my location at it highest point North. It is possible to easily spot it just after Sun set or Sun rise like this morning! The ISS reflects sunlight very brightly! I have seen it pass over not long after the Space Shuttle had separated and both the shuttle and ISS were very bright! That was about ten years ago and now I seen the ISS with the Crew Dragon! I only wish I had a good enough camera!
