

Veterans Day Special Event Station

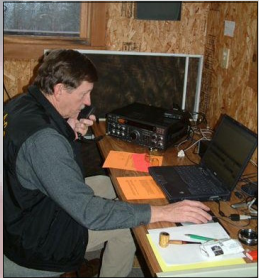
