- 2. electing officers for the new group. The officers will be: President, Vice President/President Elect, Secretary/Treasurer, and Chief Tech officer. There are candidates for each office.

If you have thought about being a VE (volunteer examiner) check the ARRL website for information. In order to be a VE, you must have at least a general class license. And you have to complete the independent study program available through the ARRL and pass the test that goes with it.
