

Travelers Bid “au revoir” to SW France

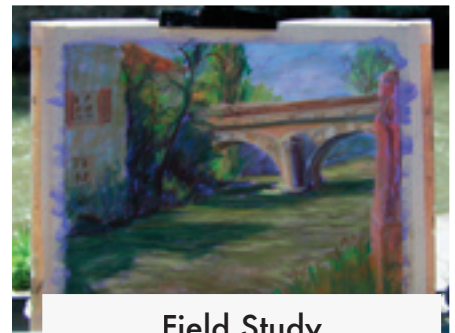
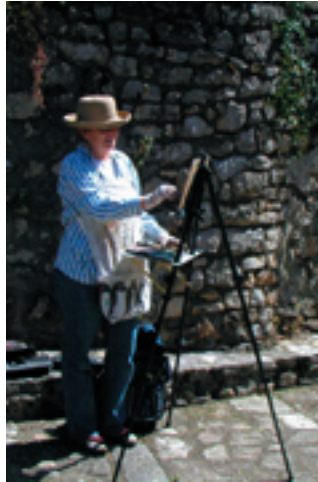
Wednesday, May 7, 2008

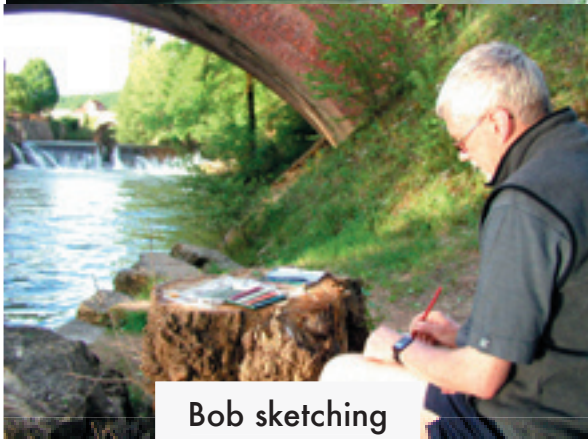
