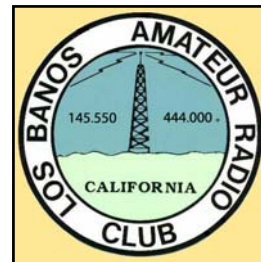

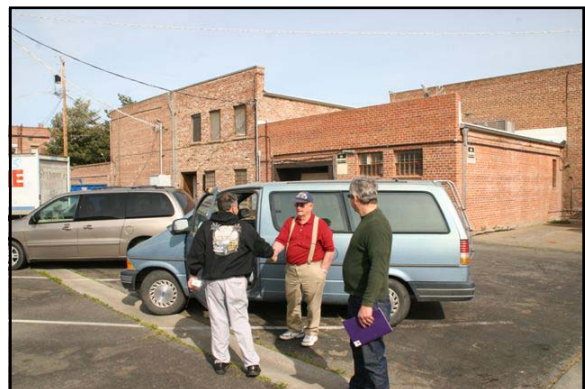

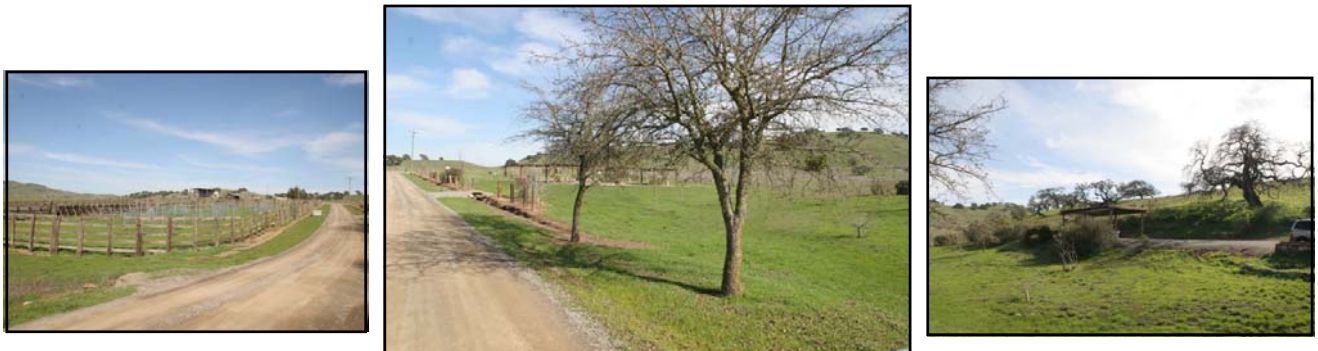

Doors open at 8:00 am Auction begins at 9:00 am.

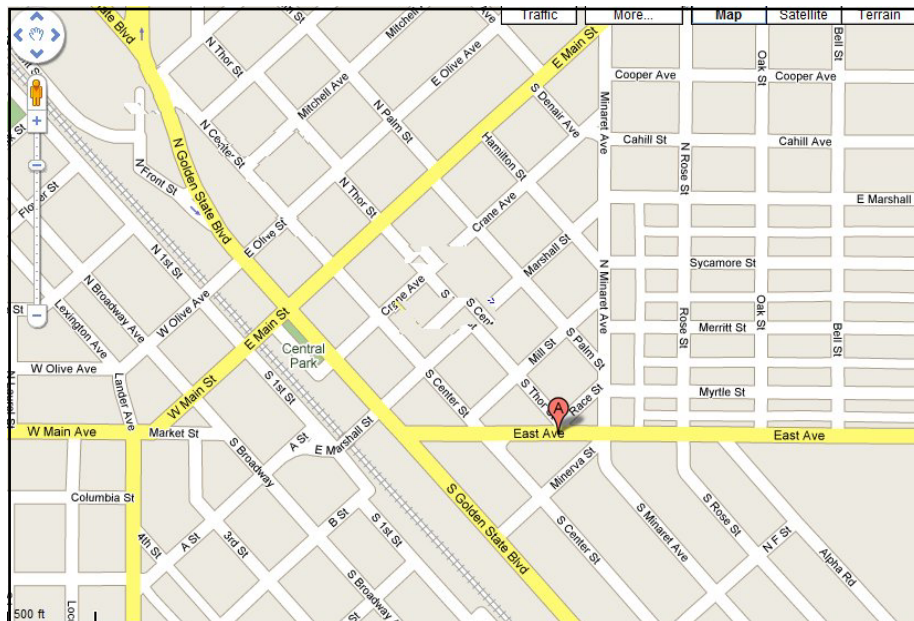
