Overview of the Event / How Was DCS Used: Communications support for the race, augmenting the Redondo DSW organization

Suggestions / Issues: Difficulties with the Redondo CRO's mobile radio required the use of handhelds at Net Control. We need to better coordinate with him in advance to have net control setup run smoother. Event was very successful nevertheless, demonstrating how we can be effective using contingency plans. In addition to net control, we also supported as shadow for the race director, at the start/finish area and at 3 of the mile positions. We provided significant mutual aid to the Redondo DSW organization without appearing to take the operation over.
