Overview of the Event / How Was DCS Used: DCS members went in 2-person teams to inspect and inventory all disaster amateur radio equipment at 24 school sites. PL tones had to be programmed on several of the 35 frequencies stored in some school radios. Three radios were found to need repair or replacement, as were two building-mounted antennas. The school district was advised in a written report of areas needing correction or fixing. On September 30, 2013, these issues were addressed by replacement of one school's vertical antenna, replacing a defective antenna connector at another school, school maintenance personnel straightening two leaning roof-mounted antennas, the District ordering replacement radios for three schools, and replacement rechargeable batteries ordered for seven school sites.
