C.E.R.T. TRAINING IS COMING TO HERMOSA BEACH SIGN UP NOW! **FREE!**

The **City of Hermosa Beach** and the **Los Angeles County Fire Department** are proud to present this training to the public.

Following a major disaster, police, fire, and medical personnel may not be able to fully meet the demand. People will have to rely on each other to meet immediate life saving and life sustaining needs. Developed through FEMA, the **L.A. County Fire Department's** Community Emergency Response Training (CERT) program provides basic training in safety and life saving skills for the public.

At the completion of the basic CERT training, students that are Hermosa Beach residents may join the Hermosa Beach Community Emergency Response Team program (HbCERT). HbCERT is a volunteer group comprised of Hermosa Beach residents authorized to provide relief to victims of disaster, assisting the City in preparing for, responding to, and recovering from emergencies.
