Repeater Status:

<u>Repeater Shack Insulation</u>. Ken, KD8RJN, measured the repeater shack for insulation and he has the insulation panels for the shack.

The 2019 ARRL Field Day results have been published in QST and on the ARRL web site. Our N8LC score of 3220 was accepted as submitted. By my count, we are number 68 in class 2A. There were 358 entries in 2A, so that puts us in the top 19%. The number one 2A station was W1NVT. It sure would be interesting to lean how they managed to get 14,876 points with two stations + G0TA. I don't know what it means, but our USECA neighbors at K8U0 (7A 5682) had 3.5 times the number of stations, but only 1.76 times more score. Maybe N8LC was a more efficient operation? HiHi

On Saturday, November 23, 2019, John/N8FYL brought over 60 bricks for the project.


