September is national preparedness month. ARRL wants all hams to be ready in case of a national emergency.

ARRL IT security hack: ARRL agreed to pay a one million dollar ransom to hackers. The ransom was covered by insurance.

Technical Committee Report: Doug/N8PYN said he switched out the 12v linear power supply at the repeater site with the new switching power supply to save on electricity consumption.

LCARC SWAP: Russ/N8HAR spoke about the USECA swap and the need to support them during their swap. He also discussed our swap on December 1st (Thanksgiving weekend) at the Balkan American Community Center at 14520 Big Beaver Road between John R and Rochester Road. He is asking for volunteer help before and during the swap.

Siren Testing Update: Marty/K8HVI provided an update on the Macomb Count Siren Testing. Over the last 2 years we have observed all 168 sirens in Macomb county. 6 sirens were tested this month and reported to the county. The sirens to be tested next month are listed on the website and you can sign up there to help.

2024 ARRL Field Day: Gregg/N8GEO gave an overview of the ARRL Field Day on June 22-23, 2024 operation from Addison Oaks County Park Campground. We had demonstrations from 10am to 2pm, right before the start of field day operations. The club had 9 stations and ran CW, SSB, Digital and satellite communications.


