**Tuned Circuit:** John/N8FYL The deadline for next *Tuned Circuit* newsletter is December 29, 2025.

**Membership Report:** John/N8FYL. We have 2 new members, Mike/N8HLN and Steve/KF8FCR. We have 95 members of which 4 are life members and 6 are enjoying the first-year free membership. 25 people have not yet renewed.

**QSL Report:** Dale/K8RO reported that he logged 7 QSO's on eQSL and 1 card this month.

**Net points:** Nothing new this month.

**Where is Doug:** Doug/N8PYN is now wintering in Florida and not at the meeting.

**ARRL Report:** Hal/W8HJP said ARRL ([ARRL Member Bulletin of September 17](#)) is still soliciting help to change the legal rights of American hams until March 2026. Go to -- <https://send-a-letter.org/hoa/>-- enter your call sign and click on "Send My Letters" and your letters will be delivered to our Washington legislative team for hand delivery to your Representative and Senators.

**Technical Committee Report:** Dale/K8RO said that when we get a strong wind out of the east that the repeater has a scratching noise in the audio. The UHF (450 MHz) repeater is working and the technical committee will meet to document the repeaters and all equipment and functionality on site. We covered the cabinets with insulation blankets and turned on the heaters inside the cabinets.

**Swap Report:** Russ/N8HAR. We are still on track with our swap this Sunday December 7, 2025, at 8 am to 12pm at the Balkan American Community Center on Big Beaver Road between John R and Rochester Road in Troy. 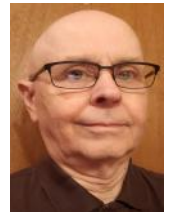
## Membership Report

# WHITE ELEPHANT RULES



1. Each player brings one wrapped item to contribute to a common pool.
2. Players draw numbers to determine what order they will go in.
3. The first player selects a gift from the pool and opens it.
4. The following players can choose to either pick a gift from the pool or steal a previous player's gift. Anyone who gets their gift stolen in this way can do the same – choose a new gift or steal from someone else.
5. A present can only be stolen once per turn, and only 3 times for the game.
6. After all players have had a turn, the first player gets a chance to swap the gift he or she is holding for any other opened gift.

## And just to keep things stirred up, here's the "rules" for the 2025 event:

Once again, we will have a White Elephant gift exchange at the January club meeting. It has always been a good time, so bring something to exchange! Here are the rules:

- Something from your basement, garage, or ham shack, that you no longer use or need, is what is needed. Hopefully it will have something to do with Amateur Radio.
- You may bring multiple gifts.
- For each gift you bring you will receive a ticket that will be used to determine the selection order.
- **All gifts need to be wrapped and all gifts need to remain wrapped until the end.** Do not unwrap any gift until after all gifts are distributed.
- The person having the first ticket will be the first to select a gift from the table and we continue the gift selection by drawing a ticket until all gifts are removed from the table.
- When your ticket is called you have the option of taking a gift from the table or stealing a gift from anyone that has one. All gifts are still wrapped, so you will be choosing solely based on the wrapping/size/weight of the package. Please do not vigorously shake packages in case some items are fragile.
- If your gift is stolen you select another gift from the table. You cannot steal anyone's gift.
- Again, **No gifts are to be unwrapped until all gifts have been selected**
- A gift can be stolen **ONLY TWO TIMES.** [ Note this is a change from last year ]

## ARRL's Semiquincentennial America250 Worked All States Award

As announced in the January 2026 issue of *QST* on page 76, ARRL is organizing a year-long Worked-All-States operating event celebrating America's 250th Anniversary. This is in conjunction with ARRL's [2026 Year of The Club](#) celebration.

ARRL will mark the semiquincentennial with special America250 [Worked All States](#) awards, including WAS and WAS Triple Play, and clubs will have opportunities to participate through W1AW/portable activations across the country — echoing the excitement of ARRL's Centennial in 2014. The first state activations begin on January 7. See details at [www.arrl.org/america250-was](http://www.arrl.org/america250-was).

In similar fashion to the 2014 ARRL Centennial Celebration, and the 2018 International Grid Chase, and 2023 Volunteer's On The Air events, this event will be exclusively driven only by QSOs uploaded to Logbook of The World (LoTW).

### Highlights of the event include:

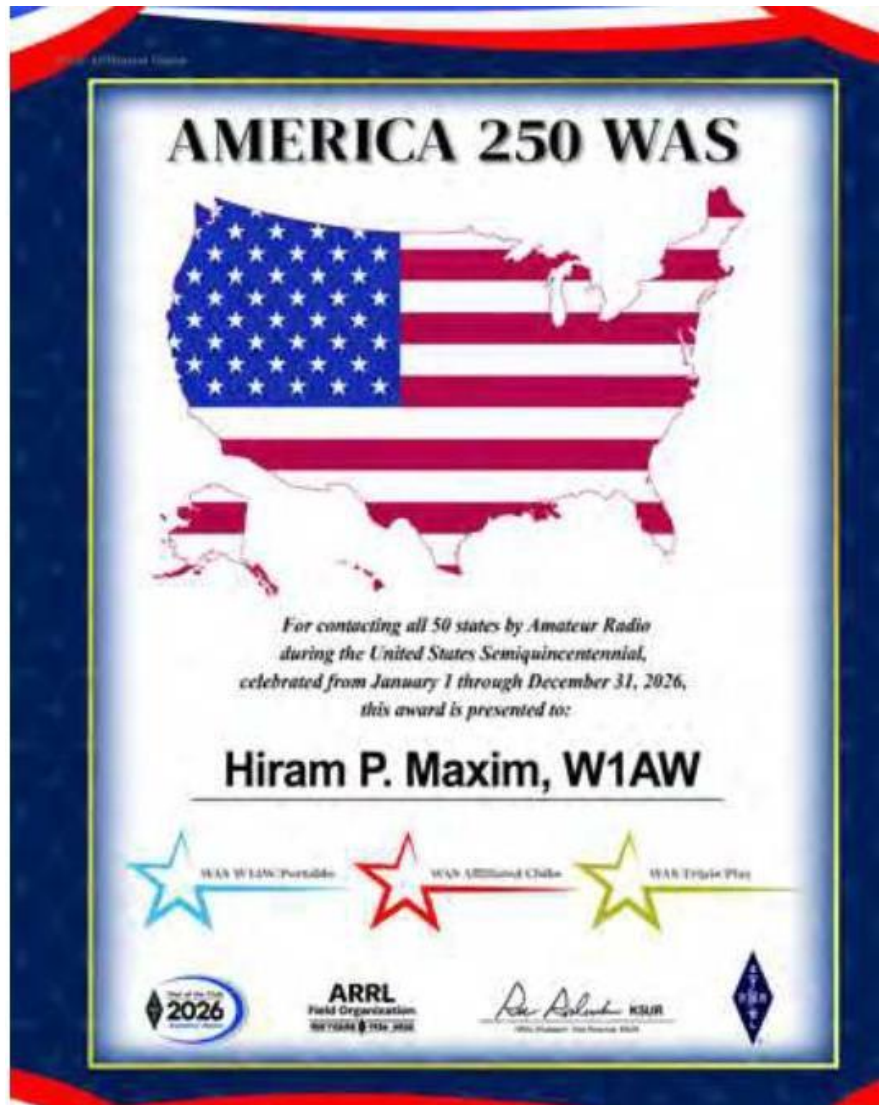
- **Work States toward achieving your America250 WAS by contacting W1AW/Portable Stations:** There will be week-long activations of portable W1AW/portable stations in all 50 states, and in several US Possessions/Territories, that will generate on-air activity to achieve this unique WAS Award. For this operating event, ARRL will provide a listing of all W1AW/portable stations, who will each operate for 7 days (from a Wednesday through the following Tuesday) for 2 separate weeks in the year (an early week between January and July, and a late week between July and December). A few weeks will be listed as non-W1AW/portable weeks due to contests and ARRL Field Day.

### There will be three (3) specialty Endorsements, including:

- [Earn WAS by contacting W1AW/portable stations in all 50 states](#) (applying for this endorsement will become possible sometime into July or thereafter when the first wave of 50-state activations is completed and the second wave of state activations is underway).
- [Earn WAS by contacting ARRL Affiliated Club stations in all 50 states](#) (see our [Club Search web page](#) to determine the locations and call signs of ARRL Affiliated Clubs).
- [Earn WAS Triple Play by contacting all 50 states on all three modes](#) (CW/Phone/Digital)

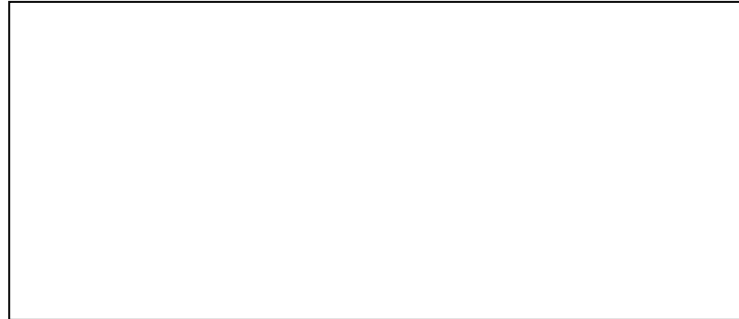

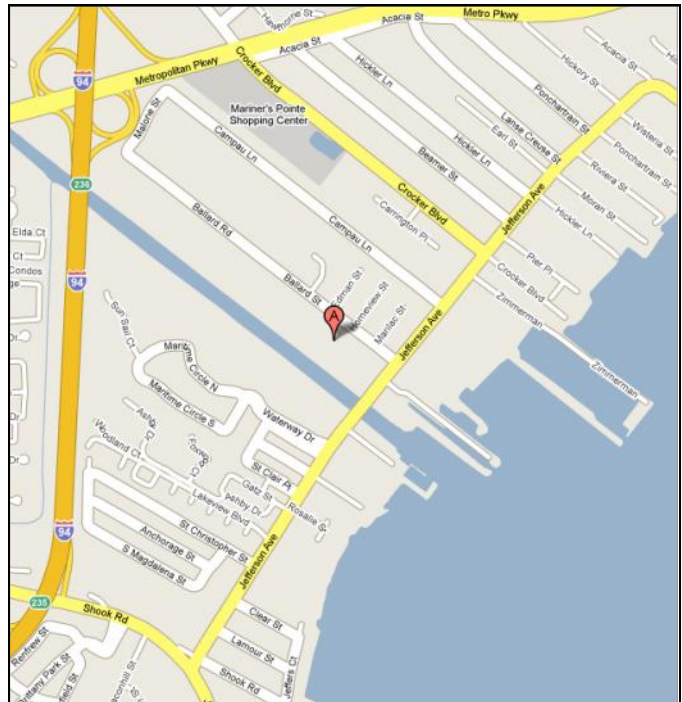
