CALL UP SCRIPT FOR THE NORTHWEST OREGON TRAFFIC AND TRAINING NET

[instructions are in italics and are not voiced]

Good evening. This is [your call], and my name is [your first name], net control station for the Northwest Oregon Traffic and Training net. This is a directed Local Area traffic net. We meet Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday at 18:05 local time on this 145.27 MHz repeater, in order to coordinate local traffic with cycle 4 of the National Traffic Network. This net meets for the purpose of handling formal written traffic into and out of Northwest Oregon and to provide training in traffic handling.

This net accepts all traffic offered and we encourage stations to originate or bring traffic to this net. In order to break the net, please use your call sign. All stations on net are expected to accept traffic for delivery in their local area.

The Northwest Oregon Traffic and Training Net is now open for stations with emergency, priority, or health and welfare traffic. [Handle in order of priority on frequency]

Are there any section net liaison stations on frequency? [Have liaisons list their traffic but take no action until after the next step to see if there is outbound for them.]

The net is now open for stations with written traffic. If you have traffic to list, please indicate so by saying 'with traffic' following your call sign, then list your traffic after being recognized by net control. Stations with traffic say your call sign.

[NCS assigns outbound traffic to be sent to the Section Net Liaison first. (Section net meets at 18:30.) Instruct stations to move off net frequency as necessary. Inbound traffic is handled next. Arrange stations in order of priority and move them off frequency as necessary. Details in the NCS guidelines.]

The net is now open for check-ins from stations with or without traffic. Again, if you have traffic to list, please indicate so by saying 'with traffic' following your call sign, then list your traffic after being recognized by net control. If you have no traffic, say "No Traffic."

Stations with or without traffic, call sign suffixes: Alpha-Delta, Echo-Hotel, India-Lima, Mike-Romeo, Sierra-Zulu, (*Late or missed*,) Alpha-Zulu
