

Winlink 2000

Winlink 2000 is a radio messaging system that links amateur radio digital protocols with internet technologies. The Winlink network serves as a backbone for robust digital communication. By providing error-free, email transmission over amateur frequencies, the system is particularly useful in emergency situations when local services are down or overloaded.

Because Winlink traffic is prepared, sent and received using an email interface, many new operators will find that the message handling functions may already seem familiar. Message protocols can also pass telemetry such as position and weather information. Over V/UHF frequencies the Winlink transmissions use AX.25 packet protocols. On HF bands, the Pactor I or preferably, Pactor II digital transmission modes are used. Because the system also connects to the internet, operators can access mail off the air through web browsers.

The Winlink package of software is free and works with a wide variety of modems including those based on computer sound-cards (e.g. using the AGW Packet Engine). Tom Kinahan will present a review of the system at the October AARC meeting (see also: www.winlink.org). If you have questions about how Winlink is configured or how the network is integrated with local emergency management systems, this would be a great meeting to attend.
