The rules of award:

- 1. Regulations of the Award "20 years of active amateur radiocommunication service on the International Space Station".
- 2. The issuer of the award is the Polish Amateur Radio Union (PZK) in cooperation with the ARISS and the organizers' special stations: **HF20ISS**, **SN20ISS**, **SN3ISS**, **HF7ISS**, **HF8ISS**, **HF9ISS**, **3Z20ARISS**, **SO1SS**.
- 3. The award activity lasts from **November 13 to December 21, 2020**, on all bands and emissions under the local regulations. We encourage you to conduct contacts through repeaters or transponders located on satellites.
- 4. The activity can be also supported by other stations. They can join any time during the activity period. List of the stations will be available at https://ariss.pzk.org.pl/20yHAMonISS/ and in the SPLOG system. two-way contact with those stations is counted as with the organizer's station.
- 5. The requirement for obtaining the Award (Diploma) is establishing two-way radio communication:
- a) by stations from Poland with at least four different organizer stations.
- b) by stations operating from the territory of Europe (except Poland) with at least two different stations of the organizers.
- c) by stations operating outside Europe with at least one of the organizers' stations.
- 6. The awards (diplomas) are only in electronic form and are generated automatically after meeting the above-mentioned conditions. The diploma file can be downloaded from the SPLOG system. More details will be available at https://ariss.pzk.org.pl/20yHAMonISS/.
- 7. There will be no diploma for SWL listening stations. A separate endeavor only for SWL stations will be available at https://ariss.pzk.org.pl/20yHAMonISS/#swl. End of the rules.
