CEPT/ERC/ RECOMMENDATION 21-13 E (Brussels 1994)

LICENSING REGIME FOR DIGITAL EUROPEAN CORDLESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS (DECT) EQUIPMENT

Text of the Recommendation adopted by the "European Radiocommunications Committee" (ERC):

"The European Conference of Postal and Telecommunications Administrations (CEPT),

considering that

- a) TBR 6 has been published and the corresponding CTR 6 has entered into force;
- b) the DECT standard provides for a wide variety of applications, such as cordless telephones, wireless PABXs, public access, local loop replacement and radio local area networks;
- c) the technical specifications stated in the relevant TBRs cover all the requirements necessary to guarantee full compatibility between the various applications offered by the DECT standard;
- d) the frequency band 1880-1900 MHz has been designated for DECT in CEPT Recommendation T/R 22-02 and in Council Directive 91/287/EEC,

recognising that

the issue of telecommunication licenses (e.g. public services) is outside the scope of this Recommendation.

recommends that

a) CEPT Administrations shall not require an individual licence for DECT equipment conforming to TBR
6 and operating on frequencies specified by ERC."
