

Chapter 126 Weekly Net Suggested Preamble

OPEN NET: “Calling the Piedmont North Carolina Chapter #126 Net of the Quarter Century Wireless Association. This Net meets weekly at 0845 local time and has been doing so since 1981. The purpose of the Net is fellowship and the exchange of information among members and friends of QCWA. Any amateur, whether a QCWA or not, is invited to check in. This _____, Net Control Station. My name is _____ and I’m located in _____. Stations checking in will be assigned a number from 1 up, and after completing their transmission turn it over to the station with the next higher number. The last station please turn it back to Net Control. Stations checking in please call now.”

After all stations have checked in, ask for any RELAYS.

Net control will advise Station #1 to start Round #1. (NCS make a note of those stations wanting to stay for ONLY one round)

After completion of Round #1, Net Control will ask for any other check-ins, assign numbers, and ask for their transmission.

After completion of Round #1, Net Control makes his own comments, then will advise Station #1 to start Round #2.

After Round #2 Net Control will make last call for check-ins.

CLOSE NET: “This is _____ closing the weekly Net of the Piedmont Chapter of the Quarter Century Wireless Association. Best Regards and my thanks to all who participated. _____ is clear.”

It is customary for the NCS to send a Net Quarterly Report of Participation to the Chapter Secretary approximately one week prior to the chapter’s quarterly meeting.
