Meeting was called to order at 10:00 by President Gary Elliott.

- Introductions were done around the room.
- Gary gave a presentation about the pending legislation relating to the regulations for museum ships.

- Gary is planning to operate K6YVM during the CQP.
- A Kenwood model 930 has been donated and will replace the ICOM
- Gary reported that there will be a 5 year celebration of the ROVs arrival in Richmond and that there will be antique appraisals in the warehouse on Sat and Sunday of this week. The appraisals cost \$10 and it is a fund raiser for the ROV.

- Bill offered to bring slide shows from ARRL for meeting programs, if we are interested.
- Bill also reported that we should be concerned about the effects of new technology of "Broadband over power lines", this is very likely to cause interference and to receive interference from Ham operations. Transmission is by square wave between 2 and 80 MHz Ouch!
- Reminder that Pacificon will be held October 17, 18 and 19, with a swap meet Sat. morning.
- Dues will be due soon. This year's membership was not well documented. But next year we will keep better records.
- Vern asked if the club should get jackets.
- There was a discussion of having more programs at the meetings.
