If you've ever wanted to learn about amateur radio and earn your license, your time has come. The Rappahannock Valley Amateur Radio Club is again offering its Spring Technician Class.

The course will begin Thursday, January 18, 2018 and will run for eight weeks. Classes will meet each Thursday from 7:00pm to 9:00pm. The final session on March 8, 2018 will be the test for the Federal Communications Commission Amateur Technician Class License.

Classes will be held in the medical office building of the Spotsylvania Regional Medical Center that is located in front of the main hospital. The address is 4604 Spotsylvania Parkway. The classrooms are on the first floor outside of the administrative offices.

The course is free and the American Radio Relay League Ham Radio License Manual, the text for the course, will be available to students at cost of approximately \$25.44. Students who pre-register, will find their manual waiting for them at the first class.
