CW

The magical world of CW is to be or not to be? That is still the big question of amateur radio today. When I became interested in Amateur Radio one had to know CW in order to receive a license. I, for one, had a hard time learning the code. I knew it, but not fast enough to pass the test that I had taken several times before I passed it.

With a lot practice I was able to copy around 13 words per minute in my head. There was talk at that time of the FCC doing away with the code requirement, but it was just in the talking stages only. Having studied for the general test, and working very hard on the code, I had a stroke that changed everything. Not only did I forget what all I had learned about the general test but all of code was also gone. Try as I may, the code was and is an impossible thing for me to learn again.

Now here I was not able to get a general license or to advance any farther in the hobby. I almost gave up on trying to do anything with amateur radio, as I wanted to do more that just 2-meters. I did start to study for the general test again and, with a lot time and hard work on my part, was able to learn what I needed to pass the written part of the test.

While in the process of studying for the written part, the FCC told us that if we would be able to get a doctor's excuse that we would not have to take the code part of the test. That was no problem for me, as it was now impossible for me to learn it again. This was at a time that AES in Cleveland was having testing for some special event they had going on at that time, so up to Cleveland I went to take the general test. The big reason that I went there was that no one knew me, so that if I failed no one down here would know it. I passed it by only missing two questions so I got my general class license.

There was a lot of talk going around about how if CW was not a requirement that amateur radio would die then and there

There were a lot of hams upset about those of us that were able to get a doctor's excuse for not taking the code. I hope that none of them ever have to go through all that I had to get to where I am now. They were saying things that were very hurtful to me and to those that have a physical problem of any kind. It almost appeared to me anyway that if one had any type of physical problem that they are an outcast to the amateur radio society The story was that without CW ham radio was doomed to die a slow death.

It seems to me that I just read that there are now more people applying for a ham license now than in all of history of amateur radio. I guess one cannot help but wonder how this could be without CW?

As I can't speak for anyone but myself, the BIGGEST drawing card to obtain new people, and to keep the old ones, is the attitude of

the ones that make up the Society of Amateur Radio. There are still some frequencies that I will not go to due to the way I was treated in the past. The future of any type of endeavor will depend on the way we act in the present. What we say, and how we say it, will and has had an effect on a lot of people. SO, please be careful when on the air or in club meetings. The success of our hobby is not on a mode or type of operation but on the individual person.
