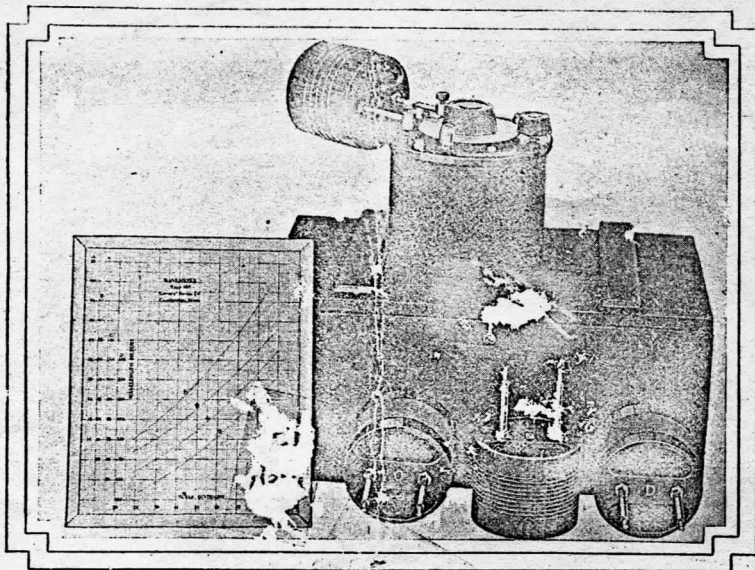

The GENERAL RADIO Type 358 AMATEUR WAVEMETER

This instrument is particularly designed for amateur use in checking wavelengths. It covers a wavelength range of 14 to 220 meters, and consists of a mechanically rugged coil of low loss construction, mounting directly on the binding posts of a shielded condenser. The condenser capacity is 125 mmf. A small lamp serves as a resonance indicator.

The 358 wavemeter is supplied with 4 coils, a calibration chart, and wooden carrying case.

The coil ranges are as follows:

Coil A	14 to 28
Coil B	28 to 56
Coil C	54 to 114
Coil D	105 to 224

Coils A, B and C are space wound on threaded bakelite forms, thus assuring accurate and permanent calibration.
