The plate supply comes from a 900 cycle motor generator. DX worked is Australia and China. Call is 6SV.

The short-wave receiver is the usual standard, with two steps of power amplifier and large Magnavox that may be plugged in.

The broadcast receiver is a Fried Eissmann 5 tube neutrodyne and Rola cone type speaker.

A code table is hooked up so either a tape machine or hand key may be used. Several keys are
