### FROM THE PREZ

Our february 10th SCCARA Meeting put on by Craig Stewart KF6SD, on SCCARA's repeater " to be ", Created much interest both in its potential for future programs possible, as well as the problems of a new location. The President was directed to contact individuals within SCCARA to head up and form such a technical committee, which effort is now in process.

In other actions the Board determined that no benefits would accrue in changing the date of the Board Meeting to precede the regular meeting by a closer margin.

A Field Day Committee to be formed to get SCCARA's program rolling. Mt. Madonna costs have been raised prohibitively on our previous site, so some new thinking is in order. Our SCCARA owned emergency Field Day equipment is ready to go.....but where?

The Board also felt it desirable to have a person function through out the year(s) as an education coordinator to keep tab on what the membership needs and provide leadership in organizing classes and teachers. The person would report to the Board. If your interested, phone Ed Rawlinson.

Also Director George Allan was appointed to assist Red Cross as part of a working committee in determining Red Cross needs in their communications.

The meeting was adjourned with the thought that SCCARA is beginning to function on a level that made it worthwhile for the great attendance of 68 members and guests at our last meeting.

18 WAYS TO KILL AN ORGANIZATION

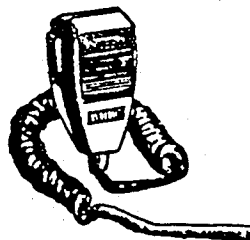
1. DON'T ATTEND MEETINGS.

### THE ABC'S OF RTTY #3

What is the procedure for calling CQ or answering a CQ? Contacts essentially should be made in the same manner as with c.w. contacts. If a station calls CQ, he will do so and include his call. Nothing different there. However, he will often send a character string ryriryryry so that the other station can tune to his signal. Remember, it is a bit harder to tune to RTTY than c.w. You'll want to give the other operator a fighting chance. Once his call stops, you would transmit back with his call and yours. Generally, you will want to send this message several times so that any additional tuning can take place. Short identification, as with c.w. contacts, is not appropriate. As an example, I may call CQ as follows:

RYRYRYRYRYRYRYRYRYRYRY  
CQ CQ CQ CQ DE W6VIP W6VIP W6VIP  
and repeat once or twice.  
I would then respond and we would be in contact.

#### UNDERSTANDING RTTY CODES AND MODES.

Radio amateurs have been using digital communications since the late 1940's. At that time most of us used machines manufactured by the Teletype Corporation, and we therefore called this mode "Radio Teletype", or RTTY for short. These early mechanical machines were surplus and operated with only one code (Baudot) and with either one of two speeds (60 w.p.m. in the U.S. and 66 w.p.m. in Europe). As the commercial teleprinter market developed, other speeds were added and we could soon operate RTTY at up to 100 w.p.m. still using the Baudot code. The advent of computers brought the ASCII 8-bit code and speeds up to 9600 w.p.m. or higher (9600 baud or 960 c.p.s., is the new "speed" parameter). A desire for an error-free radio teleprinter in ship-to-shore communications introduced the ARQ or SITON code, now called AMTOR in amateur radio circles. Recently, amateurs have adapted another commercial transmission standard to our radio's so that relatively large blocks or "packets" of text and information ("data") are sent error-free at high speed. This, of course, is called "Packet Radio". All of these techniques (and others) are generically known as "RTTY". This article will explore the similarities and differences among these various codes, speeds and modes of RTTY operation.

#### Basic RTTY Terms.

RTTYers, like other specialists, have their own special language, or vocabulary, that can be very confusing at times. In fact, we all have faced this "language barrier" when first introduced to RTTY. A short examination of how we construct the digital codes will solve this problem-----to be continued-----

For RTTY Amateurs

For coded wx reports tune to 8130,8140 kc evenings, 16440, 14853 daytime, 100 wpm,850 hz. shift, LSB. Most of the time with coded wx but occasionally in plain language.

Tune to NOJ,Kodiak, AK for Alaska wx, propagation reports and Armed Forces Radio and Television press (UPI,AP) at 0600z. Speed 100 wpm, 170 hz. shift, USB on 4333 and 6425 kc. Also try 12700 about 2000z.Sometimes propagation poor and signal not too good then.

For VOA tune to 13395 kc around 2300z, 100 wpm, 425 hz shift,USB. and 14638 kc around 1800z,100 wpm, 425 hz shift,LSB.

For propaganda tune to 14901 about 1800z,66 wpm, 425 hz shift, USB and 18193 kc,66 wpm,425 hz shift,USB. Both freqs. PRENSA LATINA from Havana, Cuba.

Also W1AW bulletins at 2300z, 60 wpm, LSB followed by ASCII at 110 baud, both modes 170 hz. shift.Occasionally AMTOR after ASCII.

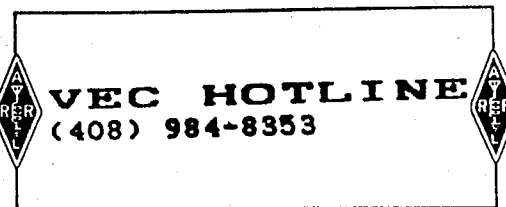
