A location plan has been developed, and, after the equipment is in place, two persons will work two hour shifts at each operating station - one person operating, the other logging. Deep-charge batteries will be used as the power source. The motor generator will be used for facilities. Antennas are on hand or promised. The treasurer's report was carried over from the business meeting.

Committee reports were requested by the president. Reporting on the convention as Shorty was unable to be there, Ed stated that programs were shaping up, thanks to Rod; and nine of the 30 exhibit spaces were spoken for by five exhibitors. Shorty had reported that the advertising for delegates was shaping up, and that this year detailed programming would be used wherever possible.

The other major item for discussion was whether or not SCCARA, as suggested by Doc Gmelin, would participate with ARES at the newly rebuilt COMROOM at Red Cross. As you may recall, when we ceased meeting at Red Cross, we bitterly removed our better equipment. Doc Gmelin had volunteered to work with other amateur organizations in removing our gear. The antennas and some of the cabinets are ours, and were left with the understanding that we retained ownership. Now the radio room (COMROOM) has been refurbished by ARES, the antennas serviced, and the room is ready to go. Doc states that

our equipment was specifically purchased with club funds for use at that facility, and that the station license is in our name. The license, of course, could be changed, BUT is that what we want? The board will recommend to the membership at the next business meeting that the SCCARA owned equipment be housed in the ARES COMROOM at Red Cross, with SCCARA retaining ownership with rights to use the equipment for field day, etc.; and that our agreement would be with ARES, not Red Cross.; and, furthermore, the COMROOM would be available for SCCARA use. This I will ask you to vote upon.

RAMBLING THOUGHTS

I have purchased a transceiver with portability, QRP, and battery power as my objectives. It is a Ten-Tec Omni A, and it works great with a deep-cycle battery for power. So far, I have used it only for CW, and the results have been very satisfying. The filters are superb, and, frankly, the QRM and crowded band conditions no longer bother me. The controls are very simple, making it a joy to use. If you are interested in CW and don't want to spend a great deal of money, check out the older Ten-Tec rigs. [Ed.: their capabilities are not limited to CW, and the newer models will surprise you.]

For antennas that perform well with good appearance, I recommend two antennas from the "ARRL Antenna Compendium": the full-wave loop and the x-beam.

The full-wave loop can be strung around your house by means of tall trees, etc., and, with the use of an antenna coupler, will permit operation on the design band and all higher bands. Choose the omni-directional model to avoid putting up more than one loop.

My requirements for a beam centered around the fact that I inhabit an environment that places a certain few but strict limitations on my RF catching structures; I couldn't put up more than one; I wanted the most for the space available; and I wanted to try DX. Therefore, a mono-bander for twenty meters seemed to be the ticket. I chose the x-beam for its compactness. A planar area requirement of about 15' by 15' makes it a relatively small full-size mono-bander. It may not have the greatest gain (about 6 db over my 80 meter delta loop on 20 meters) and the s-meter doesn't make huge excursions when I rotate it, but it does work quite well. It is significantly quieter than the loop and has gain over it. Quietness is a claimed characteristic for the loop, and the loop is supposed to have gain over a dipole on the higher frequencies.

It should have gain over a dipole, be easily assembled in fifteen minutes or less, and be less expensive than its commercial equivalent. The clock is running; build it and work some DX. Then in August or September we will all meet for comparisons. Be innovative! Maybe we can compile the best designs into a manual. All prospective entrants should contact me to indicate their interest level.

MONTHLY DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Plans for the 1987 Pacific Division Convention are being finalized. The convention, 'Pacificon 87' will be held the first weekend in October at the Le Baron Hotel, 1350 N. First Street, San Jose, California. The exact dates are October 2, 3, and 4, 1987.

Friday night's activities will include an ARES Forum with WA6OCV as the moderator. Topics include: Packet Radio in Emergencies, the FINDER program, a Certified Radio Operator proposal and a discussion about the California State Training Institute in Santa Barbara County. After the ARES forum, there will be a no-host cocktail party.

Saturday will provide a full day of activities. An 'Eyeball QSO Party' will run all day Saturday. The winner is the ham with the most eyeball QSOs during the day with log sheets that include the call and name of the 'contacts.' The Exhibitor Room will be open from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Saturday programs and forums include: Angle of Radiation (K6RQ), YL Forum (BAYLARK), DX Forum (K6SSJ), Repeaters for Beginners (a discussion aimed at the novice and the experienced user by WB6KHP), Low Band Antennas (antennas for 160, 80 and 40 meters by NJ2L, of the ARRL staff), Instructor Forum (WA6KZV), Silicon Visions (a glimpse into the future by KB6LRJ), CW Copying Contest (W6ZRJ & W6VZT), RTTY Forum (WA6AHF & W6MKM), QSL Cards (now that you worked 'em, the best way to get a card by K6HHD), Propagation Forecasting (NS6N), Club Incorporation (why and how to incorporate your club and obtain tax exempt status by NX60 & tax attorney Linda Lezotte), Antenna Legal Forum (N3AKD, ARRL Legal Counsel), AMSAT/OSCAR Forum (WB6GFJ), ATV Forum (sstv and fstv by KE6DN & K6AEP), ARES Forum (the Incident Command System and Emergency

Strike Teams). There will be a cocktail party from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. with the banquet starting at 7:30. We are hoping the new ARRL film, 'The New World of Amateur Radio' will be shown at the banquet. It is due for release in mid-September and Pacificon '87 will be the premier showing on the West Coast. A Wouff Hong is planned for Saturday at midnight.

The Exhibit Room will be open on Sunday from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. There will be a complete program on Sunday with the following sessions: RFI/TVI Legal Forum (N3AKD, ARRL Legal Counsel), PVC Pipe-The Home Brewer's Dream (inexpensive antennas for 10, 15 & 20 Meters by NM6J), Contest Forum (covering topics of interest to new and longtime contesters), Fun with Facsimile (KB6LO), Test Equipment in the Ham Shack (what is useful and how to use it), Information Services Available by Computer (W3VS), TVI/RFI Technical Session (NJ2L, ARRL Technical Staff), HF Operation for Beginners (aimed at the novice or new operator by WB6WKM). The ARRL Forum (KB6ZV and K6ITL) will give you the opportunity to ask your Director and Vice-Director questions about the ARRL, matters before the FCC and other topics related to amateur radio. The prize drawings will be held after the ARRL Forum.

Novice and Upgrade Examinations are going to be held during the convention.

Information about activities for the spouses of hams attending the convention will be available at a later date.

A block of rooms has been set aside at the Le Baron Hotel. The room charge per night will be \$48.00 plus tax for either 1 or 2 people. Be sure that when you call the Le Baron Hotel (408-288-9200 or 800-662-9896) ask for special 'Pacificon '87' rate.

The convention is shaping up to be a real nice affair. Make your plans to come to San Jose in October and meet with some of your ham friends.
