#### REPEATER COMMITTEE REPORT de WA6VJY 1/14/93

The committee had a meeting tonight to cover the upcoming move of the club repeaters to the Alum Rock radio vault owned by the City of San Jose. Members present were: Trish WA6UBE, Keith KN6K, Jerry KB6ICS, Bob KB6OHO, Mike KB6LCJ, Erik KC6SPV, Wally KA6YMD, Gary WB6YRU and Stan WA6VJY.

This was the most productive meeting we have had yet. A number of tasks which have to be completed prior to the move were decided on:

KB6ICS:

-investigate make and model of isolators for 2meters and 440.

-investigate with the phone company the installation of a phone line for our use.

WB6YRU:

-design "no break" backup power for the repeater controllers.

-design an S-meter interface to be installed in the 2meter repeater.

WA6VJY:

-purchase RC-96 controller for installation with new 440 repeater.

-research lightning protection equipment for the antenna systems.

-collect information on purchase of feed line and antennas for 440..(commercial quality equipment). -research the need to replace our current 440 duplexers.

-purchase 2 each 7' racks for repeater installation. WA6UBE:

-research and recommend an appropriate commercial antenna for this installation.

-obtain make and model number for battery chargers for each repeater for backup batteries, along with price and availability (give info to WA6VJY for purchase

KN6K:

- will assume primary responsibility for representing us at NARCC meetings in the future.

#### **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR WORK PARTY!**

Any one in the club is welcome to help us with some work at the Alexian Brothers' Hospital 440 repeater site. We have a "wall-thru" to install and a hole to repair where the feedline from the repeater goes out through a wall to the antenna. A planning meeting for this will be held sometime in March or April. Contact either Trish WA6UBE or me (WA6VJY) if you would like to help with this. This is your chance to see just what our 440 repeater looks like, and help in its maintenance.

#### PL CHANGES ON THE 2 METER REPEATER

In an effort to reduce interference caused by ducting to another repeater in the Manteca area on our pair, we will be changing our PL frequency. We currently use 100.0Hz, which is what the Manteca repeater uses. Unfortunately, when a good duct is open between the two repeaters, we bring theirs up and time it out. To prevent this from happening, we will be changing our PL frequency to 114.8Hz on February 13th. This will affect both what you will need to program into your rig, and what we transmit for users' tone squelch functions.

We have made a power increase on the 2 meter repeater recently. The ERP of the 2meter repeater is now at about 30 watts (up from 15 watts, or +3dB).

Last, but not least, the committee has purchased an ACC RC-96 controller to replace the one used on the 440 repeater. The new controller features a time of day clock and expanded vocabulary from that available in the RC-85. Most important, however, is the relative ease of connection to repeater hardware. The controller will be connected to the Motorola MSF-5000 repeater the City of San Jose allocated for our use.
