The paperwork necessary to apply for ARRL VE accreditation is now posted on the KPARC website. Go to www.kpars.ofg, scroll down to the links and click on VE Accreditation. You can also go directly to the paperwork by clicking on the following link: http://geocities.com/kparccw3sob/ARRLVEAccreditation.pdf.

General Class and above are eligible to become VE's. Our goal is to have all eligible in both clubs to complete the paperwork and become accredited. It should not take more than an hour of your time to fill out and mail the paperwork. The only cost is the stamp to mail the paperwork.

These hams led the way for others to follow:

George Pataki, KB2AQC No, not THAT George Pataki! This prolific traveler/writer ham is responsible for lobbying Senator Barry Goldwater to sponsor the legislation that eliminated the rule that limited licensing to US Citizens only. He also helped supply information that led to the publishing of the first CallBook, (American Flying Horse) of Soviet radio amateur Callsigns. This encouraged other Eastern European radio clubs to send their lists to the CallBook and the secrecy and prohibition was ended!

Paul H. Ginsparg, WA2NGB. Professor of Physics and Computer and Informational Science at Cornell University; 2002 fellow of Mac Arthur Foundation("Genius Award"); creator of an online system for distributing scientific research results, widely known as "arXiv.org; as a theoretical physicist, he has made substantial contributions in quantum field theory, string theory, conformal field theory and quantum gravity.
