General Business: Vice President, Rick Sochon thanked everyone for a successful Golf Cart Parade. The next upcoming event will be Fun Fest, Saturday March 21, 2020. President Joel Bahl dissolved positions and committees and moved them to Ad Hoc appointments as follows: Documentation, Historian, Welcome, Chaplain, Newsletter, Training, Publicity and Nominating Committee. In the future, these will be assigned on an Ad Hoc basis by the President or Board as needed. If there is a qualified volunteer that would like to be assigned to these, they can be appointed by the President or Board to assume those duties. Qualified volunteers are needed for committee heads for the following: Club Website/Communications Webmaster to keep website current, Maintain email reflector (Sun City KE4ZIP), Monitor Club email for inquiries and direct these to the correct people for response.

Club Computer Hardware: keep radio room computers running, perform base OS software updates and upgrades. This includes printers, keyboards, mouse, wifi, router and displays. Ensure that backups of important data are taken as needed and UPS power set up and tested if available.

Social Committee: Build a team to plan and coordinate events and parties (Picnic, Holiday party, Field Day, Monthly meeting refreshments.)

The radio room lock combination will be changed 1-1-2020.

Equipment Manager, Joel Bahl, sold a Pactor modem, a PW-1 Amp and a Yaesu VX-1r for a total of \$1,020 to be added to the club's treasury. Joel is still in the process of testing and sorting of used equipment.

Joel has planned a NA QSO Party on Sunday, January 19, 2020 at the radio room. All are welcomed and encouraged to attend. Joel also has plans in 2020 to offer an introduction to HF operation workshop, an Introduction to HF soundcard digital mode operation workshop and an Introduction to the ICOM 756 Pro III.
