Group discussion followed:

- 1. Program for next week Program Director out of town...Al to present a quick look at FEMA training. Also, will contact W1WAB, Bill to request presentation on D-STAR.
- 2. Methodist Church Halloween Activity Rick reported that this year will be Nativity Scenario instead of a children's party...Event still in conceptual/planning stage, but appears that SCCARC support will be needed...Rick staying on top.
- 3. Hospital emergency SCCARC support Bob opined that D-STAR will be the mode used before long...Until then, Michael will continue to investigate method for transport of packet-radio system to hospital.
- 4. SCCARC 440 repeater and KPARC D-STAR repeater Bob working with KPARC re most desirable joint-clubs usage...one possibility is to locate SCCARC 440 repeater atop Sun Towers in space previously occupied by KPARC repeater which is no longer operable/serviceable...could use existing KPARC antenna...additional height would significantly increase repeater range. SCCARC would share the use of the D-STAR repeater located at KPARC due to need of Internet connection.
- 5. SCCARC Spare and Donated Equipment It was decided to take this equipment to the Tampa Bay Hamfest in Plant City on December 6th & 7th for sale
- 6. Security Patrol Bob reported he is working with Chief Bob Powers re exploring SCCARC providing radio system support previously provided by Bill Shepard.

- 7. Election Nomination Committee Rick and KB8DW, Randy will be our nomination committee for 2014 club elections this December.
- 8. Training Occasional requests for training being received by David and Michael...Al will advertise amateur radio license training starting the second week in January 2014 in local newspapers.
- 9. Club Amateur of the Year Program for 2012 & 2013 Al will announce the program at next week member meeting & solicit nominations with supporting write-ups from all members...Nominations to be submitted to BOD NLT next BOD meeting (October 30th)...At that time BOD will select one award for 2012 and one award for 2013.
