Therefore to be on the Hospital or shelter teams you need to join ARES/RACES and register with Bill Miller. Then the Florida state insurance will cover the volunteers and they will be issued a Hillsborough County Fire/Rescue ID. The state covers firemen and sheriffs but not communicators.

The go-kits are no longer available. Some of the equipment was sold as part of the last radio sale.

Today's plan is to support local emergency efforts with the Orange Emergency signs in our neighborhoods and by placing a pillow case on the lamp post as a signal that help is needed. The amp is still out for repair and the wire antenna needs to be checked out.

Joel is planning a few classes on HRD, overview of all the radios in the shack and what do all the buttons on a hand held radio do.
