1. SPARC will operate a Class 2A amateur radio station on Field Day from Loudoun County Sheriff Station in Sterling. (2 transmitters (1 x CW/SSB and 1 x SSB plus GOTA).

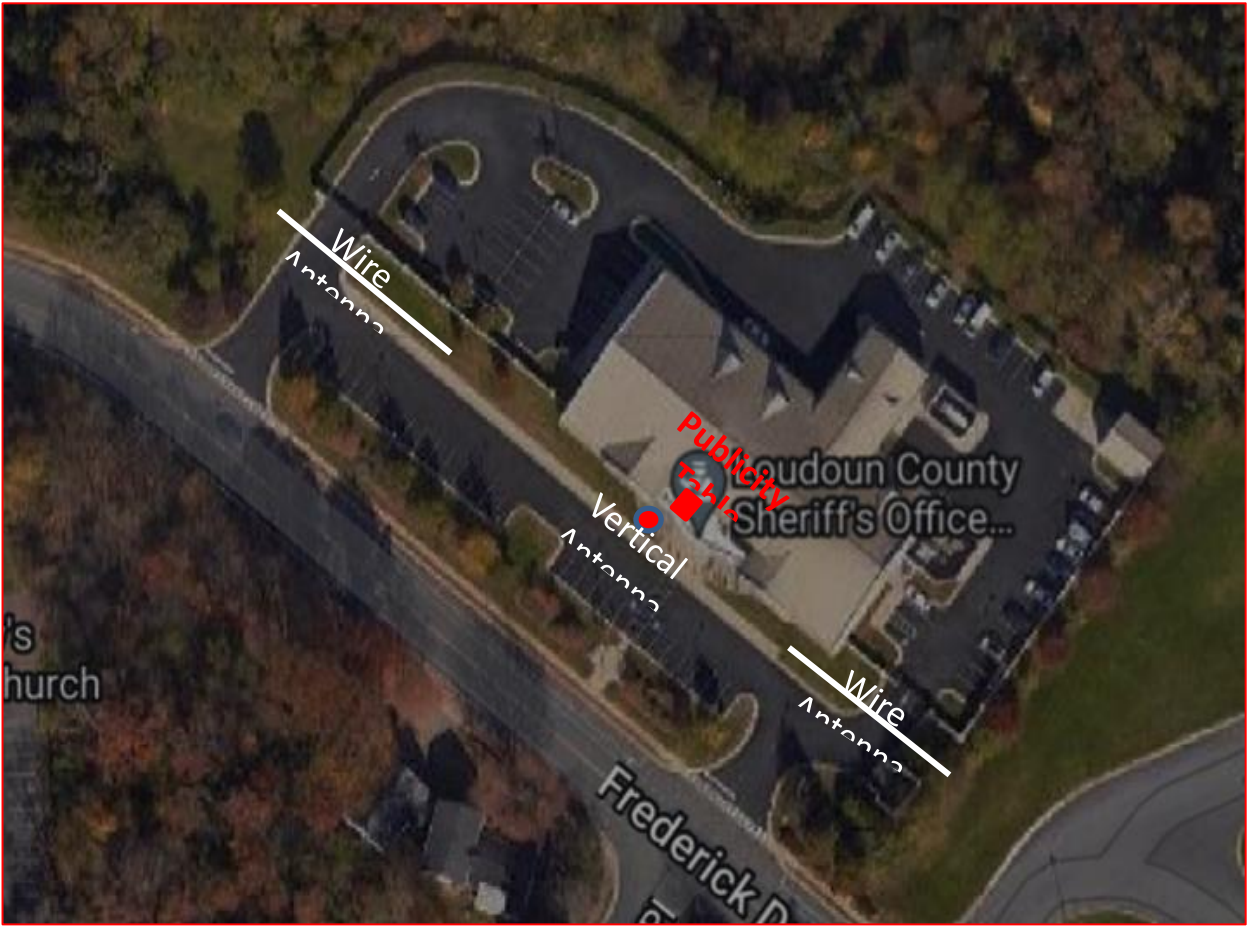

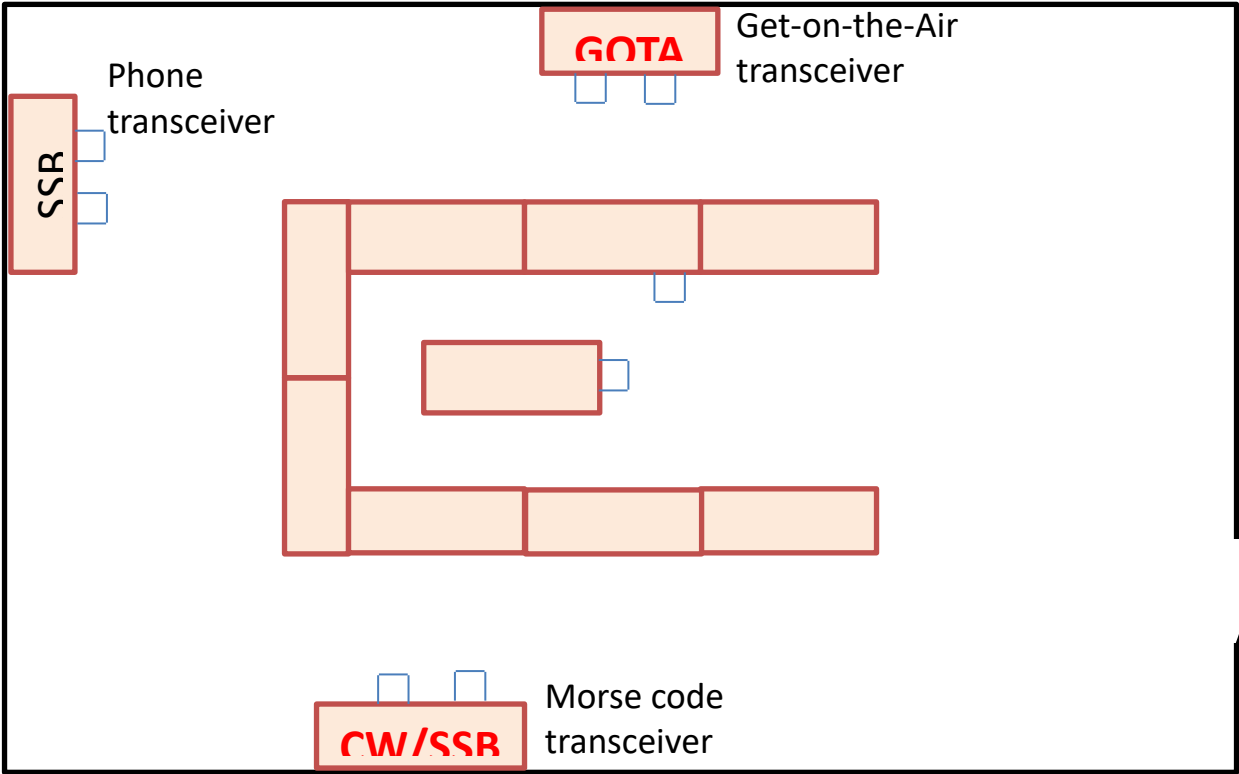

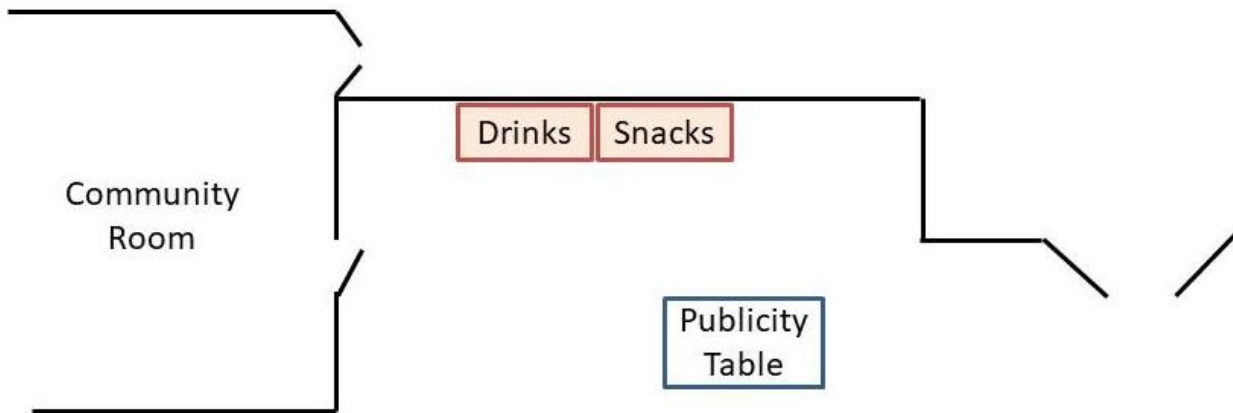
Outside layout
