Sterling Park Amateur Radio Club Sterling Fest - 120CT2013 Plan of Action

Overview:

The Sterling Foundation, a non-profit organization dedicated to improving the quality of life in Sterling Park, will be hosting its annual "Sterling Fest" on 12 October 2013. In support to this activity, the Sterling Park Amateur Radio Club (SPARC) will be hosting an information booth, providing education and demonstrations of amateur radio technologies to the general public.

Planned Activities:

For this event, SPARC will perform the following core activities:

- Interact with the Public Members from SPARC will meet/greet individuals that direct an interest with the SPARC booth. All need to be prepared to address questions specific to amateur radio, the SPARC, and how amateur radio provides relief, support during times of crises. Further, members should be prepared to address to their ability, questions regarding equipment, testing/licensing, etc. outside the core boundaries of amateur radio.
- Operations of Amateur Equipment amateur radio equipment at the SPARC Booth will be manned and controlled by members of the club. This equipment may be operated by others using FCC "controlled operations" guidelines by a SPARC member, licensed to operate utilized amateur radio bands. Members are encouraged to operate the equipment in a "GOTA-style" mode allowing non-amateurs the opportunity to experience amateur radio first-hand.
- Safeguards While operating the SPARC Booth, members will be cognizant of public safety and loss of property. It will be the responsibility of members to safeguard the public against hazards that may be attributed to the placement and operation of all equipment affiliated with the SPARC booth. All equipment used at the SPARC Booth will be placed and secured so that damage to persons or equipment will occur. A Class A-B-C fire extinguisher will be located at the booth while the festival is in operation.

Physical Location:

Sterling Fest will be held near and around the Sterling Community Center, Sterling Virginia. SPARC has been assigned site 90 (ninety) that is at the corner of Commerce and Enterprise Streets, adjacent to Sterling Boulevard (Route 845) in Sterling, Virginia. Below is an aerial map of the location.


