2014 Virginia QSO Party CABRILLO Log Format

Note: The cabrillo file format remains unchanged from last year.

Any text file can be submitted for VQP. However, CABRILLO is the preferred file format for VQP logs.

Please name your file with your call and the extension .CBR. Completely fill out the header information in the file. This will serve as your summary sheet.

When you email your log, please send the file(s) as a single attachment. For large logs or multiple files, use a ZIP utility first and label the zipped file as <callsign.ZIP>. Do not paste the log file into the text of your message. This is often impossible to extract correctly.

The subject of your email should be VQP [call_sign]. For example: VQP NQ4K.

The VQP CABRILLO Format:

Please follow the format below. Some of the logging software packages correctly follow this format. However, please check your file to make sure all of the information is correct before sending in your log.

Log header information is extracted directly into the scoring database and is the basis for your entry. If you do not fill in the header correctly, you may get placed in the wrong category.

The cabrillo format has been changed to correspond to the Cabrillo v3.0.

START-OF-LOG: 3.0 Initial entry in log.

END-OF-LOG:

Must be the last line of the log submission.

CALLSIGN: call-sign The call-sign used during the contest. Mobiles and expeditions should include "/m" and "/p" with the call-sign.

CATEGORY-ASSISTED:

Entry not used.

CATEGORY-BAND: ALL, 160M, 80M, 40M, 20M, 15M, 10M, 6M, 2M, 222, 432, 902, 1.2G

CATEGORY-MODE: SSB, CW, RTTY, MIXED

CATEGORY-OPERATOR: SINGLE-OP, MULTI-OP, CHECKLOG

CATEGORY-POWER:

HIGH, LOW, QRP

CATEGORY-STATION: FIXED, MOBILE, EXPEDITION

CATEGORY-TRANSMITTER: ONE, UNLIMITED

CATEGORY-OVERLAY:

NOVICE, TECH, ADVANCED, GENERAL, EXTRA. Also add ROOKIE if licensed for 3 years or less. Add YOUTH and age if 18 or younger.

CLAIMED-SCORE: n

The claimed score of the log submission, in integer form such as 121731 or 19113 or 12 without commas.

CLUB: Club-Name

Name of the radio club with which the score should be aggregated. Please spell out the Club Name rather than use initials. Use the ARRL recognized club names if possible.

CONTEST: contestname

Virginia QSO Party

CREATED-BY: text

Name and version of the logging program.

EMAIL:

Enter your email address.

LOCATION:

For fixed stations in Virginia, enter your county or independent city 3 character abbreviation. See the list at the VQP web site for the abbreviations. For mobile or expedition LOCATION, insert VA if more than one county or insert 3 letter county abbreviation if only one county location. For stations in the United States (outside of Virginia) or Canada, enter your 2 character postal abbreviation. For DX stations, enter DX.

NAME:

Your name.

ADDRESS:

Use multiple address lines for a complete mailing address.

The preferred address lines are: ADDRESS: 123 MyStreet ADDRESS: MyCity, MyState, MyPostalCode ADDRESS: MyCountry

OPERATORS: callsign1 [callsign2 callsign3...] A space delimited list of all operator callsign(s).

SOAPBOX:

Try to limit each line to about 75 characters. You can use as many lines as needed, but each line must begin with SOAPBOX:
