
KJ4OAP-M

On Sunday, I'll have a very familiar Sunday route with Floyd added in to make sure that one gets covered: FLO, RAX, PUL, WYT, CRL, GAX, GRA, SMY, WAS, BRX, SCO, LEE, NRX, WIS, DIC, RUS, BCH, TAZ, BLA (GIL if I'm moving fast, but wouldn't count on it)

. I've got an upgraded 2m APRS radio (I'll be using KJ4OAP-9) which I'll try to turn on at times to beacon out my QTH. Spots have seemed to work well in the past. Also, please listen/check for current QTH as it's hard for me to pick out dupes while operating.
