

## Accepted VHARA Foxhunt Guidelines

1. The fox will be located on property with public vehicular access and will not move for the duration of the event. Some examples of properties to not be used are cemeteries, school properties and hospitals.
2. The fox will transmit using only 5 watts FM into a standard vertically polarized Omni-directional antenna throughout the entire event.
3. The only transmission to occur on the designated frequency for the duration of the event is to be by the designated fox except in extenuating circumstances.
4. Hunt boundaries and all other particulars will be defined by the fox, prior to the event.
5. The fox must inform the VHARA executive committee of the foxhunt particulars no later than 12 days prior to the event.
6. All communications regarding the fox hunt will be distributed by e-mail, from a member of the VHARA club executive, at least 7 days prior to the event to all club members and frequent non-member foxhunt participants. The agreed upon set of guidelines should be included as an attachment to the e-mail.
7. The winner of the event will be determined by the first hunter/hunt team to physically locate the fox.
8. The winner of the event has the option of becoming the fox for the next VHARA sponsored foxhunt or appointing a designate.
