<u>Instructions for filing application for</u> Permanent Change of location of Amateur Radio License

General Guidelines:

As per the Office Memorandum of WPC Wing, DOT, Ministry of Communications, Govt. of India (No. P-11015/01/2019/COP dated 7th June 2019 (shown below),Amateur Radio Stations are now allowed to operate from anywhere in India, except from those locations restricted by Government of India from time to time.

b. Personal id proof

(copy of PAN card duly **attested** by Gazetted officer of Central or State Government (in PDF format and less than 1 MB)

- c. Scanned copy of License & Renewal (as applicable)
- d. Longitude & Latitude of new location
- e. New Address Proof

(Scanned copy of Aadhar Card / Consent from building owner duly attested by Gazetted officer of Central or State Government (in PDF format and less than 1 MB)

- 3. Now log into https://saralsanchar.gov.in/
- 4. Please click on "Apply for Certificates" given in left side of the page.
- 5. Please click on "Amateur Apply Now"
- 6. Please click on "Apply for Change of Location License"

2.9 Example for Change of Location Application


Any license issued through saral sanchar portal or migrated to saral sanchar portal will have the facility to apply for change of location/Renewal/Duplicate license facility, to apply for change of location click on "Apply for change of location license" button.



2.9.1 Step 1



Applicant Information: In this step the information about applicant will appear as filled in Update personal details, existing license applicant filled/migrated and will be able to upload documents once the form is saved using 'Save Draft'.



2.9.2 Step 2

Location Details: Enter Station details and upload station address proof.



2.9.3 Step 3

Payment Details:

Pay the fees using Bharatkosh Portal. Click on "Click here" as shown by arrow to redirect to Bharatkosh portal.

Make payment of Rs. 200/-

Download the application, sign in, scan it into pdf

Upload signed application



After submitting the application you will be redirected to dashboard. Upload signed application.

2.9.4 Upload Signed Application



Click on the button pointed by arrow and you will see the below screen.



Download license application and upload the signed application. In case of foreign applicant signed personal details should also be uploaded as shown.



Upon scrutiny of documents, payment etc. by WPC/WMO/DoT, necessary instructions on correction & re-uploading of documents etc. if any, would be conveyed to the applicant through email / SMS alerts. This can also be monitored / downloaded by applicants on SARAL Sanchar Dashboard of the applicant's login.

If scrutiny is not successful then applicant has to modify and resubmit it.

Applicant may **communicate** with respective WPC Nodal through portal and may also submit additional/required documents, if any. Applicant may also raise a **Helpdesk** request through portal.



Once the application is scrutinized successfully the applicant will be notified of the issue of Change of Location through SMS. The **Change of Location** can be **downloaded** from portal by logging into www.saralsanchar.gov.in and following the details given below:

- 2) Apply for Certificates
- 3) Amateur Apply now
- 4) Current Application
- 5) Action
- 6) Download Certificate
