Instructions for filing online applications for Renewal of Amateur Radio License

General Guidelines:

- 1) The renewal application may be made from 2 months before the expiry of the license.
- 2) The Amateur license Renewal fee for any grade of License is as follows:

SI.No	Period	Fee
1	20 years	Rs.1000/-
2	Life Time (ie upto the age of 80 years)	Rs.2000/-

3) Late fee shall be paid at Rs.100/- for every 6 months or part, after date of expiry of License

Note: There is no License fee to be paid by Licensees completing 80 years old. They will be issued Renewal for 10 more years at a time upon submission of other documents.

- **4)** Please keep the following documents ready before logging in https://saralsanchar.gov.in/
- 5) The documents which were submitted to apply for ASOC exam is already available in this website. The same can be downloaded and uploaded for issue of licence application.

a) Present address proof

(Scanned copy of any one of Aadhar card / Election card / Driving License / Ration Card / Electricity Bill / Bank Passbook/ Telephone bill / Rent agreement etc) duly attested by Gazetted officer of Central or State Government (in PDF format and less than 1 MB)

b) Personal id proof

(Scanned copy of PAN card / Passport etc. duly attested by Gazetted officer of Central or State Government (in PDF format and less than 1 MB)

c) Longitude & Latitude details of your location.

d) Address Proof

(Scanned copy of Aadhar card / Consent from building owner / Rent agreement for Station duly attested by Gazetted officer of Central or State Government (in format and less than 1 MB)

- 7) Please click on "WPC Apply Now".
- 8) Then click on "Apply for Certificates" given in left side of the page




9) Then click on "Amateur Apply Now"

Apply for Certificates → Amateur (Apply Now)




Apply for License → License issued outside this portal → Get Data

You will be redirected to following screen.






Click on "Add Data" pointed by arrow. You will get a form as shown below to upload your previous license details.



Make payment when prompted





Fill all the details and click on validate. If validated successfully then submit button will get activated. Once submitted it will appear in the dashboard as shown. Applicant can view or edit using the button 'View' and "Update" as shown in below screenshot.







Upon scrutiny of documents, payment etc. by WPC/WMO/DoT, necessary instructions on correction & re-uploading of documents etc. if any, would be conveyed to the applicant through email / SMS alerts. This can also be monitored / downloaded by applicants on SARAL Sanchar **Dashboard** of the applicant's login.

If scrutiny is not successful then applicant has to modify and resubmit it.

Applicant may **communicate** with respective WPC Nodal through portal and may also submit additional/required documents, if any. Applicant may also raise a **Helpdesk** request through portal.

Once the application is scrutinized successfully the applicant will be notified of the issue of Renewal through SMS. The **Renewal Document** can be **downloaded** from portal by logging into www.saralsanchar.gov.in and following the details given below:
