I mentioned <u>HamStack</u> (http://www.hamstack.com/hamstack.html) twice recently. The <u>first</u> <u>time</u> was how much I was impressed with their kits at Hamvention, The <u>second time</u> was after I obtained their HamStack Starter Pack and 8A Relay Board and was trying to figure out how best to use them in a cool ham radio application.

I have been kicking around some ideas. I would find it very useful to build a system that alerts me when 144 MHz is open. Maybe monitor the APRS channel and when the system detects distant packets, it sounds some kind of alarm and displays the DX packets on an LCD.

I'm not sure it's do-able, even if I add the HamStack LCD to my collection of HamStack kits, but I am looking into the possibilities.
