

WIT RADIO NET PROTOCOL

NEW: 6/26/2010

REVISED: 2/25/2018

“The WIT Radio net will start in 2 minutes. If anyone would like to make any last minute calls please do so now.”

“This is “WØWIT” standing by”

Pause for 2 Minutes

“CQ the WIT Radio net”

“This is WØWIT your net control station”

“This net meets daily on 147.57 simplex. We meet starting at 9 PM local time or 15 minutes after the evening entertainment has ended, whichever is later.”

“The purpose of this net is to provide a meeting place for all WIT radio members. All radio amateurs are welcome. You do not have to be a WIT Radio member or part of the WIT rally to participate. Please feel free to join in.”

“Your net control for tonight is____(call). My name is (first name). We will use our club call, WØWIT, for the net.

“If you are here on the rally grounds, please use the lowest power setting on your radio that allows you to make a good signal into net control.”

“This is a directed net. All communications will go through net control.”

“When checking in, use your full call sign and your first name. Please give your call sign slowly and use phonetics. Please listen for your call as I read them back to make sure that you were heard.”

“If you have an emergency or priority traffic say “Break or Emergency” at any opportunity.”

15 Second Pause

“The net will now standby for general check-ins. Please give your call phonetically followed by your first name. Try to spread it out. This is WØWIT.”

Write down check-ins

“The net welcomes (read the list of check-ins).”

“The net will now stand by for additional check-ins. Please call now. This is WØWIT.”

Repeat until all stations are checked in.”

“We will now go on to net business and announcements from the club officers.”

NET BUSINESS---Announcements et cetera

“We will now call on each station that has checked in for any comments.”

Get comments from each station in the order they checked in.

Before securing the net, we will take one more standby for late or missed check-ins. Any stations that wish to check into the WIT radio net, please give your call sign followed by your name.”

Welcome late comers and allow for comments.

“Secure the net! This is WØWIT with _____ (call sign) is now clear.”
