Note: Class A stations are clubs or groups operating with two or more operators. Score listings are listed according to the number of transmitters. The listings show club or group name, call sign used, total number of QSO's, number indicating power output (5<5W, 2<150W, 1>150W,) number of participants, and total score including bonus points. Class B stations are portables manned by one or two operators. Class C stations are mobiles. Class D stations are home stations using normal power. Class E stations are home stations using emergency power. Class F stations are in Emergency Operations Centers.
