Terry KB3JOD called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm hour's local time.

Presentation:

Dale Kirsch, the Indiana Area School District Superintendent, speaking on the ARISS (Amateur Radio on the International Space Station) event that is being proposed.

The Indiana Area School Board has applied to NASA for an Amateur Radio contact with the Space Station and has received notification that they have been selected. They then contacted Robert KB3JOF to see if we would be willing to partner with them in contacting the ISS. Robert informed them of our club meeting in August to present this before the club members. Dale reported this to the School Board at their July meeting. Unfortunately, the reporter for the Gazette, that was present at their meeting, twisted the information around and reported in the Gazette that it was a done deal that the ICARC was going to help the IASD with the ARISS contact. At that point the School Board still did not know if such a contact would be feasible. They are being pressured to add more STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) type of programs into their curriculum. The entire contact would take place in about a 10 to 12 minute window (the time it would take the space station to go from horizon to horizon). The Indiana Junior High School was selected as the place of this event. Time slots available are in November, December, and January. As the time gets closer NASA narrows down the time to participate.

An option other than a live amateur radio contact would be a Telebridge. *Telebridge is where a the amateur radio station may be at some distant place and he relays the contact communication by way of telephone to the participating school.*

The Contact or Mentor/Technical adviser person is Charlie Sufana, AJ9N, from Huntington Beach, California. Charlie has mentored over 60 schools and also the first school to make contact.

Larry N3LT contacted Mr. Kirsch prior to our meeting and discussed with him the substantial cost for the NASA required equipment to make such a contact. Mr. Kirsch said that they, the school board, was not aware of the equipment needed and that they would not be able to supply any financial help. Dave N3DZ came up with a list of the NASA required equipment that if we had to purchase new would cost us around \$9,000.00. Our local club members do not have the required equipment for this contact, The Telebridge maybe the best option.

If direct contact is decided upon, then roof access is a must. One possibility is if hams in the area (Pittsburgh) that may be in to the AMSAT type communications that may be able loan and help out with a direct contact.

Mr. Kirsch will contact Larry N3LT with any more information.
