The board meeting started at about 7:00 pm but no business was transacted.

The regular meeting was called to order by Doug Fitzsimmons at about 7:30 pm. The pledge of allegience was recited and a verbal roll call taken.

Terry provided the financial report and it was voted upon and accepted by the membership.

Dave Steiner reported on the net and indicated that it went off without a problem. Dave also passed out some Hoss' fund raising cards.

The ICARC repeater Trustee Joe Rankin reported that the lower of the two dual band antennas on the tower was being used for the repeater due to noise on the upper antenna. The Station Master antenna which is just for 2 m is currently not being used, it is the lowest of the three antennas.

The battery maintenance day was discussed briefly but it was decided to "wing it".

## New business

Phil Kopczyk reported that Dave Fyock from the scout project now has the tower base in the ground and that Dave is looking for help with putting connectors on the coax. Larry Freema, Dave Dzelsky, and Cass Fitzgerald have volunteered to help with that. Phil will provide their contact information to Dave so that they can arrange an appropriate schedule. Dave does not yet have the radio.

Elections were held: The officers are unchanged from last year and the Secretary position remains unfilled. The Board saw only one change. Joe Rankin, repeater trustee, replaced Elmer Sorisio on the board. The latter was not elected but comes as part of being trustee. Essentially all officers and previously elected board members were elected by acclamation. This was moved by Walter Schroth, seconded and accepted by vote.

Crucible Walk discussion has Doug Fitzsimmons agreeing to contact Dan Blevins and/or the Videographer to get still pictures or permission to take shots from the you-tube video that was recently posted of the event. These and others may be used in a possible article for QST.
