



Now to make things a little clearer, the National Weather Service has split Indiana County into two separate Weather Segments or Zones. Indiana County is one & Higher Elevations of Indiana County another. This is long overdue & should make things safer for people overall, depending where you are in the County. The forecast you hear should now be more accurate for where you live or where you are traveling in the county. Here is what the old zone looked like & what the two new zones look like.
