The meeting was called to order at 19:30 hours by President Ken Fowler. There was a sign-in sheet available. Eighteen members and

Treasurer Wood reported that October finished with \$3,292.07 in the general fund and 4,297.00 in the station fund. There was \$25.55 in income and \$79.98 in disbursements from the general fund.

Education: Fowler reported that a General License class was planned for the winter quarter. Fowler commented on the upcoming club election, and on band conditions.

Primbsch had examples of the mail-in ballot for the upcoming club officer election process.

Fowler reminded us to get our reservations in for the 4Cs / EBARC holiday lunch.

Nominations for 2011 officers were opened. The nominating committee nominated Ken Fowler for President. There were no nominations from the floor. The nominating committee nominated Jack Burris and Texx Woodworth for First Vice President. There were no nominations from the floor. The nominating committee nominated Bob Bowling for Second Vice President. Jan Sparks was nominated from the floor, and accepted. (Bob

Bowling subsequently withdrew his name from consideration due to family obligations.) The nominating committee nominated Sharon Primbsch for Third Vice President. There were no nominations from the floor. The nominating committee reported no candidate for Secretary. Randy Jenkins was nominated from the floor and reluctantly accepted. The nominating committee nominated John Wood for Treasurer. There were no nominations from the floor. Statements in support of candidates were solicited, and made.

The next meeting is December 10, 2010. A silent auction of equipment will be held, with a list to be published. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 20:01.
