He is also chasing W1AW/P stations (got all except NV) including American Samoa (helped by DX Summit spotter program).

Program: First VP Ron Smith said December will be the annual social gathering following the General Meeting. Members are encouraged to bring dessert items to share (cookies, cupcakes, etc...) Ken reported on the Boy Scout *Jamboree on the Air* event held recently. The highlight was a great QSO with an Australian station involving a troop of Girl Guides. The club received a certificate for 2013 JOTA activities. Ken also noted he's starting a new Tech license course in January at the Alvarado School for West County Adult Education. It will be 10 weeks on Tuesday evenings 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. starting January 6th 2015. The book costs \$27.00. EBARC Members are welcome to help with the course.
