**Opening:** The meeting was called to order at 7:34 p.m. by President Fowler. Sign-in sheet was circulated. A round of self-introductions was made. Minutes of the November 8, 2013 meeting were approved as published in *The Blown Fuse*.

During the introductions, President Fowler asked the question, "What improvements will you make to your station for 2014?" Responses included: Repaired a winddamaged antenna last year; None planned until I pass the Extra exam; Set up a two-radio interface for contesting; Help more fellow hams; Not a lot of time for radio; No purchases in mind; Get a long-wire antenna up; Clean up my station; and Upgrade my station from an HT to a mobile.

**Program:** First Vice-President Burris reported that tonight's program will be the EBARC Officers vote count followed by a "CW Jamboree" and social hour.

**Hospitality**: Second Vice-President Sparks was absent. Many members contributed to an excellent holiday dessert buffet.
