December 2021 General Minutes Todd Teachout, W8BIK, Secretary

The EBARC General Meeting was held December 10, 2021, virtually, via the Zoom internet conferencing application as a result of COVID-19 pandemic restrictions. 18 people attended. The President called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.

A Zoom meeting invite had been distributed via e-mail on 12/10/2021. The President, Jay, welcomed attendees.

Officer Reports:

President: Jay Sparks reported that the Election Committee, consisting of himself, Mike Camp, and Jeff Miller got together to open and count ballots. Thirty-three ballots had been returned. Jay reported that the officer slate listed on the ballot were elected to serve for 2022. There were no write-in votes. Chris Harwood is President, Katie Carney is 1st Vice President in charge of programs, Sharon Primbsch is 2nd Vice President in charge of membership, Audrey Nieman is Treasurer, and Todd Teachout is Secretary.

<u>Secretary:</u> Todd Teachout reported that the draft November 2021 EBARC general meeting minutes were published in the December 2021 *Blown Fuse* newsletter. He reported receiving no correction requests. He recommended that the group approve the minutes. Minutes approved by affirmation.

<u>3rd VP-Membership/Newsletter/VE Testing</u>: Sharon Primbsch reported the deadline for articles for the January 2022 *Blown Fuse*

newsletter is noted in the newsletter (December 28th). No new members joined EBARC in the last month. Due to pandemic restrictions the January VE radio operator licensing test session will not occur. Sharon sent out 2022 dues renewal documents and election ballots. Thirty-three responses were received as of today.

<u>Treasurer:</u> Audrey Nieman reported that in October there were no new deposits or expenses. Interest earned on club deposits was \$0.04. The October ending fund balance is \$11, 439.15 (of which \$5,000 is held in a Certificate of Deposit). There is a deadline to renew which is February 28th 2022. Missing that deadline will result in being removed from the club roster and the distribution list for the *Blown Fuse Newsletter* and any special announcements that occur.

1st VP Programs: Katie Carney reported that tonight's presentation will be a reading of an Amateur-radio-centric version of *Twas the Night before Christmas*. Attendees are invited to report about what they are most grateful for in 2021 and what they are most looking forward to in 2022. Katie also reported that she continues to refine a survey of members to gain some insight into interests and activities. She also wants your thoughts on the future direction of the club. Katie will work with Sharon to finish the survey by the end of December, sending it out to members soon thereafter. The goal is to report findings in February.

2nd VP Hospitality. No report due to absence.


Program:
