

## General Meting Minutes February 10, 2012 Mike McMillan, K6MCM, Secretary

**Opening**: The meeting at the El Sobrante Library was called to order at 7:32 p.m. by President Fowler. A sign-in sheet was circulated: 26 members and guests signed in. A round of self-introductions was made. Minutes of the January 13, 2012 general meeting were approved as published in the *Blown Fuse*.

**Program**: First Vice-President Burris reported that tonight's program will be by Mathison Ott, KJ6DZB, "My Journey into Software Defined

Radio and The Next Generation of Broadband RF Interface". Next month's program is open. **Hospitality**: Second Vice-President Sparks provided an excellent array of refreshments. **Membership**: Third Vice-President Primbsch reported EBARC has 67 members for 2012. The membership roster will be distributed soon. A VE session will be held on February 12 for Technicians only. Postage rate has gone up for mailing copies of the Blown Fuse. Finance: Treasurer Jenkins reported club financial information. General fund balance was \$4,561.20; and station fund balance was \$4,189.13. Monthly general income was \$282.25; and expenses were \$102.13. Station fund had expenses of \$163.13 (no income). Secretary: Secretary McMillan reported some miscellaneous correspondence received. Station Manager: Gleason absent; Fowler reported some sheet-metal work completed on the club station roof. Work party for roof repair scheduled for February 25, 9:30 a.m. Helpers are requested, particularly those who can work safely on a roof.

Public Events/Education: Jenkins reported the Grizzly Peak bike ride will be Sunday, May 6. Anyone wishing to help should contact Randy. Fowler reports a General license class will be starting in April at WCCAE; instructors are solicited – contact Ken if interested.

Web Page: Webmaster Hoffman reported that four presentations by Rich Holoch, KY6R, on antennas have been posted on the EBARC website. They make great reading.

**President**: Fowler reported that EBARC is having a good year. The library meeting location is assured via a new computer reservation system. DX is low.

**New Members and Guests**: Vern Orme, AA6YE, was recognized as a returning member.

**Announcements**: *Blown Fuse* deadline for the next issue is February 21, 2012. Contact Sharon, AA6XZ, if you have anything you'd like in the next edition.

**Next Meeting**: is scheduled for March 9, 2012 at the El Sobrante library.

**Closing**: There being no further business, the membership meeting was adjourned at 7:48 p.m.

**Presentation**: Following a break for refreshments, Mathison Ott, KJ6DZB, began his presentation on software-defined radio (SDR). A basic SDR system consists of a personal computer equipped with a sound card, or other analog-to-digital converter, preceded by some form of RF front end. Significant amounts of signal processing are handed over to the general-purpose processor rather than being done in special-purpose radio hardware. This produces a radio that can receive and transmit widely different radio protocols and frequencies (CW, voice, PSK, etc.) based solely on the software used. Mathison showed slides of many brands currently being tested and sold, followed by a live demonstration using Internet access through the library's system.
