

## October 2020 General Minutes Todd Teachout, KM6HFU, Acting Sect'y

The EBARC General meeting was held October 9, 2020, via the Zoom internet conferencing application. 21 members attended. President Jay Sparks called the meeting to order at 7:45 p.m.

Self Introductions/Ice Breaker: Tell the group what you did with radio in the last month.

Draft September General Meeting Minutes were published in *The Blown Fuse*. Call for corrections. None offered. Motion to approve-Sharon. 2nd by Ron. Vote-no objections to minutes approved.

#### Officer Reports:

**3rd VP**: No new members last month. Released the October *Blown Fuse*. Deadline for next issue is October 27. Articles needed. No VE session in Oakland in October. Some discussions started about 2021 VE schedule though no dates set, yet.

**Treasurer:** \$0.02 in income, from interest in club checking account. Final balance is \$8,971.36. No new mail, no bills, no payments.

**1st VP:** Working on having a presentation about meteor scatter for the November meeting. The December meeting will be a Holiday Special. Katie is reaching out to UC staff about holding Winter Field Day there. A site not yet secured there, so alternative sites are also being considered.

Member at Large Mathison: Reported about FCC action to deauthorize some parts of the 3MHz band for ham use to allow commercial 5G to operate. Cal OES is preparing a virtual CERT training module. Propagation was good enough this morning to allow contacts with European hams on 17m.

Nominating Committee: Ron Smith, Chair reported that members have agreed to serve in the positions of President, 1st VP-Programs, 3rd VP-Membershiip/VE/Blown Fuse, and Secretary. At the moment the Treasurer and the 2nd VP-Hospitality positions have no candidates. Mathison agreed to be considered for 2nd VP. Jay asked participating members if anyone would like to be Treasurer next year. No volunteers. Jay encouraged people to consider serving and indicated if there was desire, to contact him via e-mail.

Election: The pandemic has impacted the club election process. The candidate slate is finalized at the November meeting. As in the recent past, 2021 ballots will be mailed out, consistent with Bylaws. Members have until the week before the December meeting to cast and submit votes. Ballots are to be returned via U.S. Postal Service mail. The Election Committee counts and certifies the election results. The winners are installed in December and serve for the following calendar year. The 2021 Election Committee will be Ron Smith, D.J. Djovida, and Maria Hauger.

**President:** Great thanks to member Chris Harwood for allowing much of the Club Equipment to be stored in his garage.

The Storage Committee met in September. Discussions continue.

The Field Day Committee will meet 10/9/2020 following this General Meeting.

**Meeting Topic:** What do members want to talk about?

Mathison: Requested member Joe Fisher's Field Day log. Joe submitted it to the Austin Radio Club, which he also belongs to. Mathison indicated he still needs the results to document Club member's efforts. Mathison provided his e-mail address to assist (not being disclosed here).

Eric Thompson: Questioned if Winter Field Day is an ARRL sanction event. It is an event run by the Winter Field Day Association. The ARRL does mention it in QST, but does not sanction it.

Ron Smith: Will Winter Field Day be at UC Richmond Field Station? Katie reported that the location is not yet confirmed. There is a UC Radio Club station there. Winter Field Day will not be run from that station. Maybe outdoors. Maybe elsewhere.

A Trivia Point: In 1996 Ron assisted with the set up for Summer Field Day at Caesar Chavez Park in Berkeley. Another member, John, also assisted. Equipment was set up. After set up Ron went home to test reception. Ron and John were able to make contact in every band authorized at that time, before the Field Day started. Contact was made between Berkeley and El Cerrito.

D.J. reported that the 4Cs (Contra Costa Communications Club) operates a 3 band net on Saturday mornings at 9:00 a.m. The bands are 2m, 1.25m, and 70cm.

The 4Cs also meets on Sunday. Due to the pandemic they aren't meeting at Denny's. Check their website for particulars. He invited anyone interested to tune in and check in.

Brief mention about drones with "situational awareness."

Brief mention about meteor scatter, drone scatter, satellite scatter. A point was made that

there are so many satellites orbiting the earth that sometimes it looks like a train flying overhead. More info at findstarlink.com.

Katie departed the meeting around 8:45 p.m. She turned Zoom control over to Jay.

Sharon motion to adjourn the meeting. Ron 2nd motion. Motion passed.
